As the focus on the teaching of Mathematics in primary schools becomes ever-more intense it is essential that all primary school teachers have a deep subject knowledge and appropriate pedagogy. We are pleased to offer a Subject Knowledge Enhancement course to support primary teachers and teaching assistants in ensuring that their subject knowledge is up-to-date and able to cope with the requirements of the new primary programme of study. The course will also focus on Teaching for Mastery principles and how these can be embedded into maths teaching to improve student outcomes.

Through successful completion participants will be:

- confident in their mathematical understanding
- confident in explaining maths to pupils
- inspired and enthused by mathematics
- able to use and develop classroom activities and tasks for teaching Mathematics in the primary sector
- Aware of the principles of Teaching for Mastery and how these can support learning.
