

Selective Mutism: 3-Day Advanced Masterclass for Professionals, Parents and Carers. Presented by Maggie Johnson

Participants on this course will study the nature and causes of Selective Mutism, differential diagnosis, theoretical frameworks and evidence - based intervention strategies.

On days 1 and 2 the course will introduce participants to an inclusive 24/7 approach to promote social comfort and participation. When applied consistently within family and educational settings, these techniques will enable some children to fully overcome their difficulty talking, while laying a firm foundation for more formal small-steps intervention programmes if indicated. General principles to maximise progress are discussed, together with a guide to troubleshooting and dealing with regression.

On Day 3 participants will build on an introductory grounding in Selective Mutism, this session looks at conditions which frequently occur alongside Selective Mutism and asks participants to consider their roles and remit when supporting children and young people who are experiencing more than Selective Mutism. Adaptations to standard assessment and intervention techniques are discussed, together with additional management techniques and medication.

Day 1 & 2

- Profiling, diagnosis and assessment - Management approaches; the 24/7 approach - Creating stress-free environments - Small-steps approaches and programmes for school-aged children - Working with adolescents and disengaged individuals - Guidance for troubleshooting and dealing with regression

Day 3

- Introduction to co-existing conditions - Extended assessment: general principles - Assessment and management of speech and language difficulties (including learning English as an additional language) - Autism Spectrum Disorders: the question of dual diagnosis, assessment and management - Mental Health Issues: implications and possible involvement of CAMHS - Identification and management of other anxieties and phobias - Behaviour issues and Medication - Involving other professionals and agencies - Case studies and case discussion
